

**Richard B. Lipton, M.D.**

Dr. Lipton is a Professor and Vice Chair of Neurology, and Professor of Epidemiology and Population Health at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York. He is also Director of the Montefiore Headache Center and Principal Investigator of the Einstein Aging Study, an NIA program project now in its 30<sup>th</sup> year.

Dr. Lipton's interests include headache epidemiology and clinical trials, outcomes research, and cognitive aging and dementia. Dr. Lipton is a three-time recipient of the H.G. Wolff Research Award for excellence in research from the American Headache Society. Additionally, he and colleagues are the recipients of the Medical Book Award from the British Medical Association. Dr. Lipton has published 8 books and over 600 original articles and reviews. He also is an Associate Editor of *Cephalalgia* and on the editorial boards of several journals including *Neurology*.
